Through running, Marathon Kids has transformed the lives of more than 2.5 MARATHON million children. We have recently introduced this in our school as the programme gives primary school children the opportunity to run or walk

multiple marathons over the school year. Mr Lewis takes each year group out once a week (weather permitting) for up to 30 minutes. This is either on the field or on the MUGA. Please note that children can bring their trainers in order to do this activity!

Please can I reassure you that all children are told that they can wear their coats (most choose not to or take them off whilst running) and also, each child is able to go at their own pace to build up their stamina!
