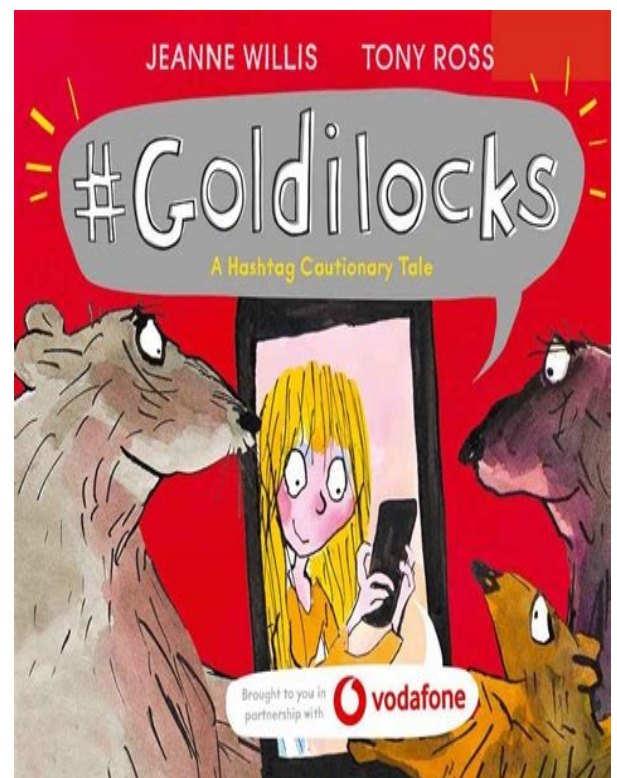
**Together for a better internet**
