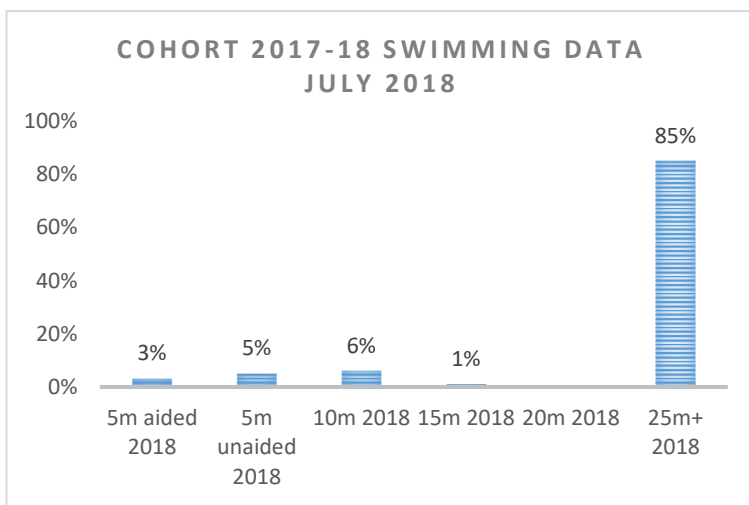
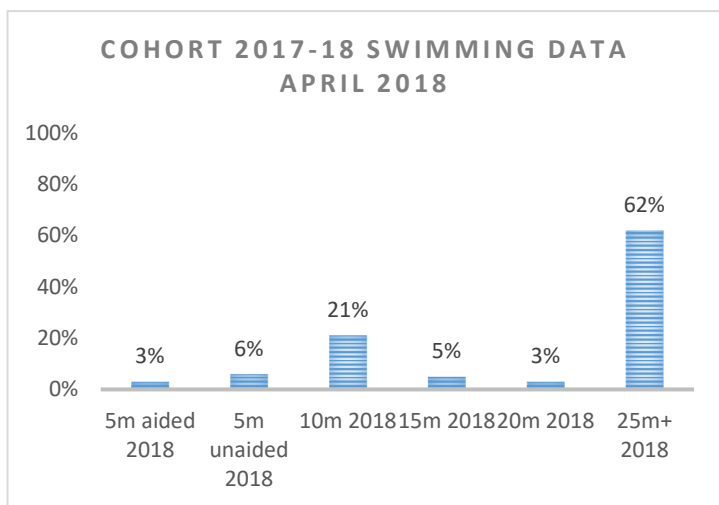




St Luke's Primary School Swimming Data Year 6 2017-18

All children from Year 2-6 swim for one term per academic year.

Year 5 and target children from Year 6 swim for an additional half a term each.
