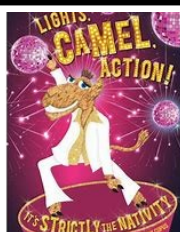

**Year 5 for working so hard on their DT cooking project—amazing mince pies and also, for doing St Luke's proud when CBC came in!**

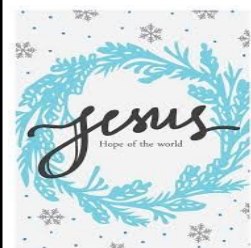
