Is your child entitled to Free School Meals or Pupil Premium funding?

This is really important for our School Funding. Remember all children in Reception, Years 1 and 2 are entitled to a Free School Meal thanks to the Government but we still need you to check whether you are eligible for Pupil Premium Funding. Thank you!
