TAKING CHILDREN OUT OF SCHOOL DURING TERM TIME

Due to the increasing number of parents/carers asking to take children out of school during term time, any parents considering taking children out of school will now be required to attend a meeting with either Mrs Grennan or Mrs Smith and our Attendance Officer. No holidays or tickets should be booked before this! Government Legislation does not allow us to permit holidays during term time. Children have 13 weeks of holiday from school each year, including a long summer break. This allows time for family holidays, including visiting family abroad for events such as weddings, etc. The City Council will fine parents if there is evidence that

your child has been on holiday, etc and your child's place at our school could also be at risk. Children have been off-registered due to being absent from school for an unauthorised period of time. Please think carefully about taking your child out during term time—it has a major impact on your child's learning and progress and as you can see, our attendance.
